### GRADE Groups

*New for 2018*

Pre-K – Kindergarten  
1<sup>st</sup> grade – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade  
3<sup>rd</sup> grade – 4<sup>th</sup> grade  
5<sup>th</sup> grade – 6<sup>th</sup> grade  
7<sup>th</sup> grade – 8<sup>th</sup> grade  
9<sup>th</sup> grade – 10<sup>th</sup> grade  
11<sup>th</sup> grade – 12<sup>th</sup> grade  
Adult – 18 years and older

- \* Due to smearing, GRAPHITE and CHARCOAL must be properly fixed with a fixative
- \* Must be the original work of the artist and not a copy!

**For General Public:** Art Exhibits will be accepted at Fairgrounds Saturday, October 6, 2018 from 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. Only two entries per Art Medium per exhibitor will be accepted, however you can enter all 3 mediums. Judging begins at 2:30 and is not open to the public.

### **For Teachers:**

Teachers may bring a maximum of 100 art exhibits. Please bring your student's entries to the Fairgrounds on Friday, October 5, 2018 between 3 – 5 p.m. OR Saturday, October 6, 2018, between the hours of 9 a.m. – 2 p.m.

**Professional:** Persons who receive payment for their work, offer instruction, or represent a commercial concern are considered professional and are not eligible to enter.

## GUIDELINES

1. Security guards will be in the Exhibit Hall building; however, The Exchange Club is not responsible for damages to or loss of entry, including damage from water/rain. The Exchange Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
2. All art must have a firm backing. This should include a mat, foam board or heavy poster board/paper. Because of safety and space, art in frames with glass **will not** be accepted.
3. All exhibits will remain in Exhibit Hall building until Sunday, October 21, 2018. Exhibits can be picked up on Monday, October 22, 2018 from 3:00 – 6:00 p.m.
4. Entry tags are available by request **after September 7, 2018**. Tags will be available for pick up at the Gertrude Herbert Institute of Art (506 Telfair St. Augusta, GA 30901) or you may call 706-722-5495 and we will mail them to you. Or, you may fill them out on Saturday, October 6 at the Fairgrounds
5. Art smaller than 5" X 7" should not be entered. Due to limited space, art larger than 16" X 20" will be placed on the floor at the artist's own risk.
