## Photography Guidelines

FAIR DATES: Friday, October 12 – Sunday, October 21, 2018

### CATEGORIES FOR PHOTOGRAPHS

**\*\*Revised for 2018\*\***

**PEOPLE:** Adults, children, babies, portraits or entire figures, alone or in a group where the main subject is the person rather than the environment; close-ups or as part of a large composition.

**ANIMALS:** Animals, birds, fish, reptiles, insects or household pets either alone or in a group.

**SCENIC:** Landscapes, seascapes, architectural and industrial scenes or any image where the setting is the primary subject of the piece.

**GRAPHIC DESIGN/OTHER:** Prints not fitting into any of the above categories, including graphic design, hand-tinted or manipulated images. This included black-and-white prints that have been hand tinted or colored.

**For General Public:** Exhibits will be accepted at the Fairgrounds Saturday, October 6, 2018 from 9 a.m. – 2 p.m.

Only four entries per category per exhibitor will be accepted. Judging begins at 2:30 p.m. and is not open to the public.

**For Teachers:** Please bring your student's entries to the Fairgrounds on Friday, October 5, 2018 between 3 p.m. – 5 p.m. OR Saturday, October 6, 2018, between the hours of 9 a.m. – 2 p.m.

**Professional:** Persons who receive payment for their work, offer instruction, or represent a commercial concern are considered professional and are not eligible to enter.

### GUIDELINES

1. Security guards will be in the Exhibit Hall building; however, The Exchange Club is not responsible for damages to or loss of entry, including damage from water/rain. The Exchange Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
2. All art must have a firm backing. This should include a mat, foam board or heavy poster board/paper. Because of safety and space, art in frames with glass **will not** be accepted.
3. All exhibits will remain in Exhibit Hall building until Sunday, October 21, 2018. Exhibits can be picked up on Monday, October 22, 2018 from 3:00 – 6:00 p.m.
4. Entry tags are available by request **after September 7, 2018**. Tags will be available for pick up at the Gertrude Herbert Institute of Art (506 Telfair St. Augusta, GA 30901) or you may call 706-722-5495 and we will mail them to you. Or, you may fill them out on Saturday, October 7 at the Fairgrounds
5. Art smaller than 5" X 7" should not be entered. Due to limited space, art larger than 16" X 20" will be placed on the floor at the artist's own risk.
