General Rules for the Model Exhibit

- 1. The purpose of the Model Exhibit is to allow the General Public to exhibit their models. Additionally, there is a model contest for those who wish to participate. Persons who receive payment for their modeling work in a commercial business are considered professional, and therefore are not eligible to enter models in the model contest; but can exhibit their models in the model booth.
- 2. Exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor. Exhibitors may exhibit as many models as desired in a category (given the booth's physical space). Exhibitors may enter as many categories as desired. **There is no exhibit or entry fee.**
- 3. Every precaution will be taken to protect exhibits, but exhibits are entered at owner's risk.
- 4. Exhibits must be securely fastened together and contain no loose pieces. Multiple piece exhibits should be securely fastened to a display unit. The exhibitor must furnish the display unit.
- 5. Exhibit tags will be available at the model booth. To reduce the time to enter your exhibits, exhibitors are encouraged to bring return address labels pre-printed with their home address, one label for each exhibit (your return address label is quick and easy to affix on exhibit tags). Exhibit tag stub must be presented to claim exhibit after the Fair.
- 6. Exhibits must be entered in the model booth, in the Community Building at the Fair Grounds **Saturday October 6, 2018** between **9:00am 2:00pm.**

(NOTE: Please enter the Community Building through the 3rd street side door.)

7. All exhibits must remain in the Community Building through, October 21, 2018. Exhibit pick up is **Monday October 22, 2018** from **3:00-6:00pm**.
