* Due to smearing, GRAPHITE and CHARCOAL must be properly fixed with a fixative (cheap hairspray works well)

* Must be the original work of the artist and not a copy!

For General Public: Art Exhibits will be accepted at Fairgrounds Friday, October 8, 2021, from 3 – 5 p.m., OR Saturday, October 9, 2021, between the hours of 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. Only two entries per Art Medium per exhibitor will be accepted, however you can enterall 3 mediums. Judging is not open to the public.

For Teachers:

Teachers may bring a maximum of <u>100 art exhibits</u>. Please bring your student's entries to the Fairgrounds on Friday, October 8, 2021 between 3 - 5 p.m. OR Saturday, October 9, 2021, between the hours of 9 a.m. - 2 p.m.

Professional: Persons who receive payment for their work, offer instruction, or represent acommercial concern are considered professional and are not eligible to enter.

GUIDELINES

- 1. Security guards will be in the Exhibit Hall building; however, The Exchange Club is not responsible for damages to or loss of entry, including damage from water/rain. The Exchange Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 2. All pieces must have a firm backing. This should include a mat, foam board or heavy poster board/paper. Because of safety and space, pieces in frames with glass **will not** be accepted.
- 3. All exhibits will remain in Exhibit Hall building until Sunday, October 24, 2021. Exhibits can be picked up on Monday, October 25, 2021 from 3:00 6:00 p.m.
- 4. Entry tags are available by request <u>after September 9. 2021</u>. Tags will be available for pick up at the University of Georgia Cooperative Extension Service at 602 Greene Street Augusta, GA 30901. Or, you may fill them out when dropping off your entry at the Fairgrounds.
- 5. Pieces smaller than 5" X 7" should not be entered. Due to limited space, pieces larger than 16" X 20" will be placed on the floor at the artist's own risk.
